These flyers serve as a valuable tool for educating the community on proper irrigation run times, promoting endorsed members, and highlighting the Waterwise Programs. An electronic version is available for inclusion on websites, quotes, and more.

As part of your WIDS endorsement, it is expected that you distribute these flyers to your customers to educate them about the appropriate sprinkler run times. Additionally, these have proven to be a valuable resource when customers are in search of WGIPs (Waterwise Garden Irrigators).

Catch Cups (if applicable)

Catch cups (graduated measuring containers) are a valuable tool for testing how efficiently an irrigation system is operating and the sprinkler application rates.

These catch cups are regularly supplied to the store (if applicable) throughout the year and are available to customers free of charge. We kindly request that you become familiar with their usage in case customers seek assistance on how to use them.

Instructions:

- spread catch cups or containers of the same size randomly around the watering zone
- make sure they are at least 1 metre from the closest sprinkler
- time how long it takes the sprinklers to fill the catch cups to the depth of 10mm this is the standard drink for an area of sandy soil.





Controller Cards

These tools play a crucial role in educating your customers on the optimal operation of their irrigation system. It is imperative that you provide customers with a controller card so they have access to all the pertinent and essential information.

It's easy to 'set and forget' your irrigation system. It's important to regularly check that your system is working correctly, you can do this by:

- · Regularly checking for leaks.
- · Ensuring your back-up battery is kept charged.
- Asking a Waterwise Garden Irrigator or visiting a Waterwise Irrigation Design Shop, for advice and other tips, they have been trained to help you save water by providing waterwise advice, products and services.

Seasonal adjustment setting

As the seasons change, so do the water needs of your lawn and garden. The table below shows the adjustments that should be made to your irrigation controllers 'Seasonal Adjustment' setting to avoid over watering.

No matter what the season, your controller should always be turned off when it's raining.

| Time of year | Seasonal adjustment (most suited to Perth and the South West) | | |
|---|--|--|--|
| January-February | 100% | | |
| March | 80% | | |
| April | 60% | | |
| May | Manual operation of controller as necessary | | |
| June August | System turned off (winter sprinkler ban) | | |
| September | Manual operation of controller as necessary | | |

Sprinkler watering rates

It's important to remember that different types of sprinklers have different watering rates. By reducing sprinkler run times you will save water and your garden can still look great. The table below can be used as a guide if you need to reset your controller.

| Sprinkler type | Approximate watering rate (per hour) | Suggested run time to apply 10mm (standard drink) | Recommended run time for reducing water use. |
|--------------------|--|--|--|
| Pop-up/fixed spray | 35-45mm | 13-16 minutes | 10 minutes |
| Rotary | 10-15mm | 40-60 minutes | 30-40 minutes |
| Gear drive rotor | 10-20mm | 30-40 minutes | 25-30 minutes |
| Dripline | 15-20mm | 30-40 minutes | 20-30 minutes |
| Micro spray | 35-45mm | 13-16 minutes | 10 minutes |

If you are establishing a new garden or lawn, you may be eligible for a watering exemption in order for it to become fully established. For more information about exemptions and how to be waterwise call 13 10 39 or visit watercorporation.com.au


